PROGRESS REPORT

(SESSION 2017-18)

Panjab University Constituent College, Nihal Singh Wala (Moga) imparts quality education in the rural areas across the district since 2011. During session 2017-18, college achieved distinguished advancements in the field of Academics, Cultural Activities and Sports. Due to the sincere efforts of the Principal, Dr. Kuldeep Singh and college staff, this institute has achieved great progress during this session. College has organised many activities like hosting of Youth and Heritage festival of Moga- Ferozpur Zone A, Mobile app of college for students, seminars, sports activities etc. The college has progressed in leaps and bounds towards achieving holistic development of students. The highlights of our college activities are as follows:

Hosting of 59th Zonal Youth and Heritage Festival:

► In the session 2017-18, with sincere efforts of Dr. Kuldeep Singh (Principal) and Dr. Nirmal Jaura (Director, Youth Welfare, Panjab University, Chandigarh), college hosted a grand event of 59th Zonal Youth and Heritage Festival of Moga-Ferozpur Zone A, on 18, 19, 20 and 21 September, 2017, on the theme “My Nation, My Responsibility”. The worthy Vice Chancellor, Dr. Arun Grover, of Panjab University, Chandigarh inaugurated this Festival. Other eminent personalities of Panjab University, Chandigarh named Dr. Raunki Ram, Dr. Parwinder Singh, Dr. Parminer Singh, Dr. Navdeep Goel also graced the events.

The college was first amongst other Panjab University Colleges to develop and deploy an online system for entries of youth festival. The college was also first to give online generated printed certificates along with QR code. The whole system was developed by Mrs. Simranjeet Kaur (Assistant Prof. In Computer Science) of our college. More than 1300 students of total 22 Colleges took part in different events. Our College has won five 2nd positions, nine 3rd positions and one Appreciation Award in this Zonal Youth and Heritage Festival. Overall, our College has won 6th Overall position amongst 22 participated colleges. The event was a success owing to the tireless efforts of Ms. Rajni Bhalla (Organizing Secretary) along with entire teaching and non-teaching staff of the college.

National Seminars:

► On February 3, 2018, One Day National Seminar “**Emerging Trends in Business, Economics, Information Technology and Social Studies**” sponsored by Dean College Development Council, Panjab University, Chandigarh was organized. Different eminent personalities from the fields of Information Technology, Commerce, Social Sciences and Economics delivered key note speeches. Approximately 100 delegates from different educational institutes graced the event. This seminar emerged as a boon for students and faculty members being its multidisciplinary nature.
