Accomplishments


As an activist teacher, taking dynamic part in different teachers' movement for creating better teaching-learning scenario has always been my priority. Since 2000, I have been holding Punjab &

Chandigarh College Teachers' Union office in various capacities such as District President, Member State Executive Committee, Area Secretary Panjab University, General Secretary and State President. As an office bearer in diverse capacities, I have been given assorted responsibilities which include various deputations to DPI Colleges Punjab, Special Secretary Higher Education, Principal Secretary Higher Education, Education Ministers, Finance Secretary, Secretary Expenditure, Finance Minister, Deputy Chief Minister Punjab, Chief Minister Punjab, Governor Punjab and Vice Chancellors of State Universities of Punjab. Convoluted errands - like submitting teachers' grievances relating to the pay revision to G K Chadha committee at PU CHD - have provided me a chance to dwell deep into the pragmatic predicaments of teachers' community at different levels.

I have been representing the college teachers and taking care of the interests of students by participating in various important committees like College Development Council for about six years, Standing Committee of College Development Council for four years, UMC Committee for one year and Revising Committee for one year. Apart from these, various other committees concerning semester system for UG classes, choice based credit system, Research promotion amongst college teachers, committee for fee of college students, NET exemption granted to college teachers etc have given me an opportunity to cater to the needs and requirements of effective teaching-learning process in Higher Education.
